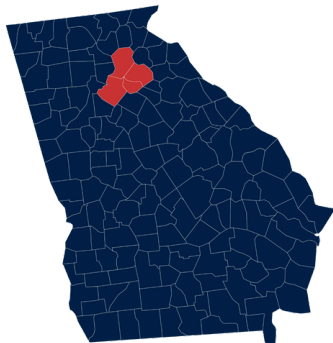

SERVING NORTH GEORGIA VETERANS SINCE 2019



Chateau Elan Military Support Foundation is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization that was founded by a group of neighbors to organize and fund aid supporting military veterans and their families in North Georgia. There are over 600,000 veterans living in Georgia, with approximately 54,000 veterans living in north central Georgia alone (Barrow, Gwinnett, Hall and Jackson Counties). Since 2019, Chateau Elan Military Support Foundation has distributed over \$225,000 to support veterans in North Georgia, focusing on Barrow, Gwinnett, Hall, and Jackson Counties.

2025 IMPACT

2025 was our biggest year yet supporting North Georgia veterans. We increased distributions by **219%, growing from **\$32,902** in **2024** to **\$105,074** in **2025** to better meet the needs of those who served.**

Our Support of North Georgia Veterans in 2025

in assistance to North Georgia veterans for basic needs and other support. This direct support included paying utility bills, car repairs, food donations, Christmas gifts, and move-in supplies for the residents of the new Tunnels to Towers facility in Georgia. We identify veterans in need through our partnerships with other local organizations serving veterans.

\$29,000**

in housing assistance for North Georgia veterans. In 2025, we repaired and renovated two disabled veterans' homes, ensuring they have safe and suitable living conditions. We also sponsored a Habitat for Humanity Gwinnett build for a veteran and his young daughter. In addition to these projects, we provided over \$11,000 in emergency assistance to 10 veterans to either prevent eviction or to provide temporary housing.

in funds to support mental health for North Georgia veterans. Through our partnership with The Headstrong Project, we are funding free mental health sessions in Barrow, Gwinnett, Hall and Jackson Counties. We grant funds to PTSD Foundation of America to be utilized exclusively for mental wellness aftercare services for veterans returning from Camp Hope within Gwinnett, Hall, Barrow, and Jackson counties. We also support Doc's Healing Hives, a North Georgia organization that helps veterans heal through the vocation of beekeeping.

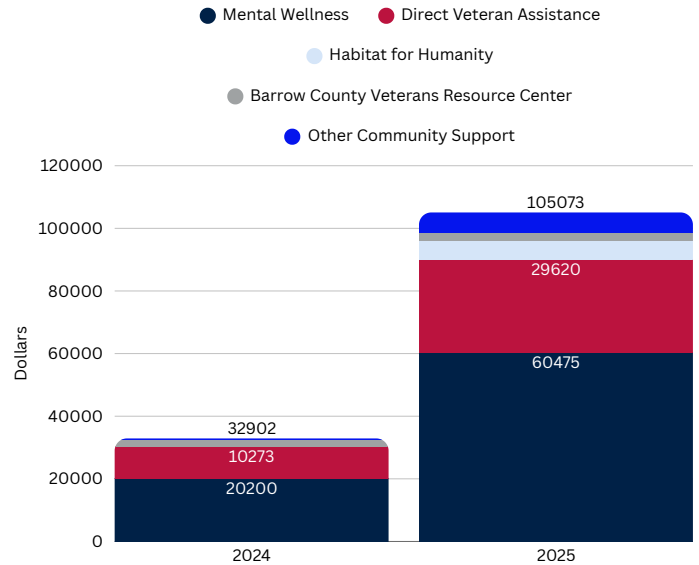


DIRECT VETERAN ASSISTANCE

In 2025, we supported 23 North Georgia veterans with direct assistance for essential needs including car repairs, utility bills, emergency housing, essential home repairs, Christmas gifts, and more — helping prevent veterans from falling through the cracks during times of need.

MENTAL WELLNESS

Mental health is a critical issue for North Georgia veterans, who face higher suicide rates and significantly increased prevalence of PTSD compared to the general population. In response, we have made veteran mental wellness a priority, committing a minimum of 50% of our overall distributions to programs that support mental health and well-being. In 2025, we exceeded this goal by distributing 57.6% of net operating income for this purpose.
